

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-11

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNALAKLEET AMENDING CHAPTER 2.16
CANVASSING OF ELECTION RETURNS**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF UNALAKLEET, ALASKA, AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: **Classification.** This ordinance is of permanent nature and shall be codified in the Unalakleet Municipal Code.

Section 2: **Severability.** If any provisions of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons shall not be affected hereby.

Section 3: **Amendment of Chapter 2.16, Canvassing of election returns.** Unalakleet Municipal Code Title 2, Elections, Chapter 2.16 Canvassing of election returns, is hereby amended as follows:

2.16.050. Committee report of findings.

The canvass committee will submit a report of its findings to the council before noon of the ~~Monday~~ **next business day of the week** following the election.

2.16.060. Public declaration of results.

A. If a contest is not begun under the provisions of AS 29.26.070, the result of the election shall be publicly declared by the council and entered in the minutes of a special meeting of the council on the first ~~Monday~~ **business day of the week** following the election.

Section 4: **Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be published as provided by law and shall be effective upon adoption.


